- Public housing residents
- Low and very-low income persons who live in the area or county where a HUD-assisted project for housing or community development is located.

Section 3 Businesses:

- At least 51 % or more owned by Section 3 residents
- Has permanent, full-time employees, at least 30% of whom are currently Section 3 residents
