Emergency Housing Voucher

The Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) program is available through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Hopewell Redevelopment and Housing Agency (HRHA) has received a limited number of EHV's to assist individuals and families who are eligible under the following categories:

- Experiencing homelessness;
- At risk of experiencing homelessness;
- Fleeing, or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking;
- Recently homeless and for whom providing rental assistance will prevent the family's homelessness or having high risk of housing instability.

To ensure that the EHV's assist families who are most in need, the HRHA is working with the local area partner, all Crater Area Coalition on Homelessness (CACH) participating agencies.
