The waiting lists will <u>close</u> on: May 31, 2024, at <u>5:00 PM</u>.

Waiting lists are subject to close earlier than May 31, 2024, if lists reach the maximum limit of 500 applicants.

As stated in the HRHA Administrative Plan:

Preferences establish the order of applicants on the waiting list. An admission preference does not guarantee admission. Every applicant must still meet HRHA's Selection Criteria before being offered a voucher. All Preferences will be treated equally regardless of preference. HRHA has the following HCV preferences:

Residency Preference - Families that live and/or work in Hopewell.

The Residency Preference will not have the purpose or effect of delaying or otherwise denying admission to the program based on the race, color, ethnic origin, gender, religion, disability, or age of any member of an applicant's family.

Working Families - Head of Household or Spouse or Sole Member is aged 62 or older or is a person with disabilities or where the Head of the Household is the primary caregiver for a disabled household member. Minimum work hours 15 per week for non-elderly and non-disabled.

Veterans - Person who were honorably discharged or under other than dishonorable conditions.

Olmstead Preference - Applicant families with disabilities who reside in institutions who are ready to leave the institution for community-based living.

Domestic Violence - Victims of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault or stalking.

Elderly/Disabled - Head of Household, Spouse or Sole Member is aged 62 or older or is a person with disabilities.

Homelessness - Individuals with this preference will provide verification of status through an organization identified through the State or Local continuum of care.

Involuntarily Displaced - Involuntarily Displaced or about to be Involuntarily Displaced by government action, fire, natural disaster, domestic violence, to avoid reprisals, hate crimes or due to the inaccessibility of unit.

Involuntarily Displaced HRHA - Involuntarily displaced due to a real estate acquisition by HRHA.
